
#### ABOUT OUR CURRENT INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS:

We are currently coordinating 3 Erasmus+ projects in the field of Higher Education and Adult Education.

These projects have started at the end of 2023, with the main goal of improving accessibility, development, and digitization of international adult education. In the projects we are accompanied by partners from various European countries. All projects are EU-funded.



This project's main goal is to raise awareness and motivation for teaching and learning opportunities with AI-technologies. The project will familiarize teachers and self-learners with the advantages of AI-supported learning and encourage them to create more engaging and interactive learning experiences by using AI technologies such as speech recognition, machine translation, and natural language processing.

#### **Forecast Newsletter No 2**

In the next newsletter, we will focus on three central projects that will further advance our international exchange and the promotion of lifelong learning:

Intercultural Trainings: We will present our Intercultural Training Courses, which are offered to institutions, teams or classes, both in the university context and in other areas of work.

UNESCO-Project: We are glad to give you an insight into our newly launched UNESCO research project which is conducted as part of a second agreement with the Shanghai Open University (SOU). The project focuses on intergenerational learning at universities worldwide.

Among other things, JGU supports mobility programs in the area of language tandems between Germany, France and Spain. Our new mobility project will start in September 2024 which will enable Elder Learners (primarily 50+ but also other interested people) to engage in online exchanges and on-site excursions with native speakers at the partner universities abroad.
